LOS ANGELES (Reuters) - Hundreds of people marched in the heart of Hollywood on Sunday to support victims of sexual assault and harassment, inspired by a social media campaign that has portrayed such abuse as a pervasive feature of American life.
August and in France and Germany last year.

Senate Republican leader calls on Alabama candidate Moore to 'step aside'

WASHINGTON (Reuters) - U.S. Senate Republican leader Mitch McConnell on Monday called on the party's Alabama Senate candidate Roy Moore to "step aside" because of allegations he had sexual contact with a 14-year-old girl decades ago.
McConnell told reporters in his home state of Kentucky that party officials were considering whether a Republican write-in

candidate could be found to challenge Moore in the Dec. 12 special election.
He said Luther Strange, who lost the Republican primary to Moore earlier this year, was being considered as a possible option.
McConnell said he believed the women quoted in a Washington Post story on Thursday about Moore's relationships with them as teenagers, including a charge



that Moore initiated sexual contact with a 14-year-old girl when he was in his 30s.
McConnell had previously said Moore

should step aside if the allegations were proven true.
"I believe the women. Yes," he said, according to a video of his session with reporters.
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After an uncharacteristic show of diplomacy during his three days in Beijing, US President Donald Trump’s return to form at the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation summit in Vietnam on Friday was evidence of the tension that remains in the battle for dominance in the Asia-Pacific.

In a fiery and confrontational speech in Da Nang, Trump accused countries in the region of trade abuses that the US would no longer tolerate, and pledged to “always put America first”.

His tone was in sharp contrast to that of Chinese President Xi Jinping, who spoke after Trump and made no bones about his support for globalization, saying the trend towards it was “irreversible”.

“Openness brings progress while self-seclusion leaves one behind,” Xi said.

Wary of the unfolding rivalry between the world’s two biggest economies, Asian nations have followed Trump’s first visit to China attentively, trying to decipher Beijing’s complex love-hate relationship with Washington and the personal interactions between Trump and Xi.

To many people’s surprise, the US president’s stay in Beijing was largely hassle-free and uneventful.

Instead of much-anticipated diplomatic wrestling over North Korea, trade, Taiwan and the South China Sea, Xi, at the height of his power after being elevated to Mao Zedong-like status last month, exchanged flattery with the embattled Trump, who has been plagued by protracted political chaos at home.

Apart from offering Trump lavish ceremonies, grandiose banquets and a rare respite from protesters and unfriendly media coverage, Beijing also signed more than a dozen

business deals worth more than US\$250 billion in a move to appease Trump’s discontent over America’s trade deficit with China. Most of the deals were signed in the form of non-binding memorandums of understanding, instead of contracts.

With Trump hailing Xi as a great leader and a friend he respects, observers predict their flourishing personal ties since their first meeting at Trump’s Mar-a-Lago estate in Florida in April may prove useful to steer Sino-US relations through uncertainties and simmering tensions.

But they could hardly alter the geopolitical landscape of structural competition brought about by the relative decline of the United States and rise of China, they said.

“The competition for influence in Asia is well under way and will probably grow fier-

er,” said Timothy Heath, a senior international defence research analyst at the RAND Corporation. “The future of the global economy will be centred on Asia, and the United States cannot afford to neglect that region.”

While China’s rise offers regional opportunities for economic prosperity, such as the “Belt and Road Initiative”, Xi’s signature push for global trade and infrastructure development, it has also stirred fear and anxiety among many neighbours.

“The US will thus remain an essential player in ensuring peace and stability in a region full of historical animosities and uncertainty,” Heath said.

Analysts said Beijing’s increasing assertiveness under Xi, especially on its expansive territorial claims, had shifted the balance of power and rendered a formula that had worked for the past quarter of a century effectively useless.

“The dualist approach of ‘going with China for economics and going with America for security’ that many countries in the region have pursued will bring more problems than benefits for them in the future,” Alexander Vuving, a China expert at the Daniel K. Inouye Asia-Pacific Centre for Security Studies in Honolulu, said.

“We are witnessing the beginning of a historical moment of ‘destructive creation’ where countries in the region are seeking and building new approaches to regional security.”

From Beijing’s perspective, the White House’s repeated talk of a vaguely de-

fined Indo-Pacific and an emerging US-led quadrilateral alliance targeting China were alarming and might become new irritants in China’s relations with its Asia-Pacific neighbours, Pang Zhongying, a Beijing-based international affairs expert, said.

“It looks set to revive Beijing’s bad memory about former [US] president Barack Obama’s signature pivot to Asia strategy targeting China – albeit under different names,” he said.

The revival of the “quad” – the US, India, Japan and Australia – first initiated a decade ago is the latest example of an emerging strategic grouping to balance China’s military and economic clout.

Acting US assistant secretary of state Alice Wells said late last month that the informal grouping was aimed at providing alternative options to help countries in the Indo-Pacific region, but denied it was designed to contain China.

Japan has been the most vocal supporter of the US-led initiative, but India and Australia were not enthusiastic about it until recent months, in the face of China’s perceived challenges to the existing, US-led world order.

Australian politicians, including Prime Minister Malcolm Turnbull and Foreign Minister Julie Bishop, have repeatedly warned against alleged attempts by Beijing to influence Australian politics and China’s expansionism in long-standing South China Sea disputes, calling them “direct disregard” of international order.

China’s recent border stand-off with India in the desolate Doklam plateau in the Himalayas had also served as a wake-up call for New Delhi, Dibyesh Anand, a China expert at London’s Westminster University, said.

“Indications are that China’s discontented neighbours, including India and Japan, will not remain silent spectators but forge clos-

er relations with the US and each other,” he said.

With growing competition between Beijing and Washington, Southeast Asia’s mostly small nations would have to turn more and more towards hedging and try to keep out of the way of major rivalries, Jay Batongbacal, a maritime law expert at the University of the Philippines, said.

Unlike mid-ranking powers such as Japan, Australia and South Korea, which were capable of taking a more active role to fill in any voids left by the US, smaller countries had few options left.

“If China continues to press itself on these smaller countries it might actually encourage them to coalesce more rapidly to protect themselves from the possibility of more extreme or harder-edged policies of China,” he said.



Unlike his predecessors, Xi has pursued a bolder and more assertive foreign policy and no longer emphasises the need to reassure the US and Asian neighbours that China’s rise will be peaceful, something he saw as a sign of weakness.

But his ambition to project China’s economic and military power beyond the Asia-Pacific region has strained Beijing’s relations with key regional countries such as Japan, India, Australia and South Korea, and also North Korea and Taiwan.

China’s trade and investment push through chequebook diplomacy, which has seen Chinese investment back many new road, rail and port projects in Asia, has also had a mixed record in reducing suspicions and antagonism towards Beijing.

Many analysts said a watershed moment in Beijing’s relations with its neighbours came when then foreign minister Yang Jiechi snapped at his Singaporean counterpart at a 2010 regional meeting in Vietnam: “China is a big country and other countries are small countries, and that’s just a fact.”

Vietnam, which for more than a year has been the lone vocal opponent of former communist ally China in the South China Sea disputes, was also at the forefront of the competition between Beijing and Washington, observers said. (Courtesy <http://www.scmp.com/news>)

The Boy Scouts of America announced plans on Wednesday to broadly accept girls, marking a historic shift for the century-old organization and setting off a debate about where girls better learn how to be leaders.

The Boy Scouts, which has seen dwindling membership numbers in recent decades, said that its programs could nurture girls as well as boys, and that the switch would make life easier for busy parents, who might prefer to shuttle children to a single organization regardless of gender. “I’ve seen nothing that develops leadership skills and discipline like this organization,” said Randall Stephenson, the group’s national board chairman. “It is time to make these outstanding leadership development programs available to girls.” The decision was celebrated by many women, but criticized by the Girl Scouts, which said that girls flourish in all-female groups. “We’ve had 105 years of supporting girls and a girl-only safe space,” said Lisa Margosian, chief customer officer for the Girl Scouts, who added that the organization felt “blindsided” by the announcement. “So much of a girl’s life is a life where she is in a coed environment, and we have so much research and data that suggests that girls really thrive in an environment where they can experiment, take risk and stretch themselves in the company of other girls.”

For families involved in scouting, the announcement led to a scramble of questioning phone calls and frantic Facebook discussions as parents and scout leaders wrestled with tentative plans for the transition. Next year, girls will be allowed into the Cub Scouts program, which had been limited to young boys. A program for older girls is expected to be available in 2019, giving them a path to earn the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.

ed access to some programs before, but it has never before welcomed them into its core Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts programs. And the introduction of girls still does not mean that Boy Scouts’ gatherings will necessarily include both genders. The smallest groups of Cub Scouts will continue to be single sex.

Michael Ver Duin, a third-generation Eagle Scout and troop leader in Grand Haven, Mich., said he was “super excited” for the change — an opportunity, in his view, for girls to have the same choices as boys. “The closest I’ve had to a negative comment is ‘I know there will be some who do not welcome this,’” he said. “The two biggest things I see as a challenge to explain to parents are, ‘What kind of problems are you going to have if you had boys and girls on the same camping outing?’ and ‘Do boys need time to be boys and girls need time to be girls?’”

Others were deeply skeptical. Joseph Carballo, 70, has been with the Boy Scouts for 30 years, most of that time as a scoutmaster of Troop 65, in the Bronx. His two sons, both Eagle Scouts and now in their 30s and 40s, have been with the organization since the 1990s. “And we all have the same view: no girls,” he said.

“Boys and girls should have separate organizations for activities,” Mr. Carballo explained, as his troops entered the cafeteria of St. Helena’s Church for their Wednesday night meeting. “There is an organization for girls. It’s called the Girl Scouts.” (His granddaughter, he pointed out, is a member.)

For the Boy Scouts, the change is also a chance to boost its sagging membership. The group says it has 2.3 million members between the ages of 7 and 21 and nearly a million volunteers throughout the United

States and its territories. At its peak in the 1970s, the organization, incorporated in 1910, was closer to five million members. The Boy Scouts has significantly loosened its membership requirements in recent years, but not without lengthy debates among its leaders and members. In January, the organization announced it would accept transgender members. In 2013, the group lifted a ban on openly gay members, and in 2015, it stopped barring gay Scout leaders.

In April, the Boy Scouts began exploring the possibility of opening more widely to girls after receiving inquiries from its members, a spokeswoman for the Boy Scouts, Effie Delimarkos, said. She said the group collected input from families over the summer and, on Wednesday, its directors unanimously voted to allow the expansion.

For some parents, the announcement came as an answer to longstanding complaints that offerings by the Girl Scouts were lacking, particularly for girls with less traditionally feminine interests.

“The problem with the Girl Scout curriculum is that it’s very focused on who your leader is for your particular troop,” said Rebecca Szetela, a mother of four from

Canton, Mich. “If you have a mom who’s really into crafts and girlie stuff and being a princess, then that’s what your Girl Scout troop is going to be like. If you have a daughter who’s more rough and tumble, it’s not going to be a good fit.”

Some girls, like Ella Jacobs, 12, of Sebastopol, Calif., have long argued for the chance to be allowed into the Boy Scouts. “My point has always been that there’s absolutely nothing wrong with the Girl Scouts, but they weren’t the right fit for our family,” said her mother, Danelle Jacobs, a lawyer. “Girls should have the choice.”

Brian Seeton, a scoutmaster in Canton, Ohio, predicted that the acceptance of girls would play out much like the acceptance of gay Scouts and leaders. “Parents and kids didn’t care one way or the other,” he said. “It’ll only be an issue for the first couple of years and then it’ll carry on as it always was.”

Bryan Spellman, a scoutmaster in Fishers, Ind., pointed out that there already were girls in some scouting programs, and that while the announcement was somewhat sudden, it would ultimately work out.

“Honestly, I don’t mind it at all,” Mr. Spellman said. “I think Scouting is one of the greatest youth organizations that we have in this nation. And if that’s something that can be shared with all sexes, it can be fantastic.”

He said he suspected not everyone would feel that way. “There’s resistance to change,” he said. “People hate change, and people love tradition.”

Perhaps most vulnerable in all of this, he said, are the girls’ organizations that may be at risk of losing members or potential members. “Everybody knows an Eagle Scout,” he said. But the Girl Scouts’ top award “is just not held as high or as valuable in people’s minds, and I’m not sure why.” (Courtesy <https://www.nytimes.com/>)

FBI: Hate crimes rose in 2016

Americans carried out more hate crimes in 2016 than in 2015, according to new data from the FBI, which shows an uptick in acts directed at Jewish people, Muslims and the LGBT community.

Last year, law enforcement departments across the country reported 6,121 criminal incidents, according to the FBI statistics. That compares to 5,818 such crimes reported in 2015. More than 70 percent of the incidents were based on race or religion, the FBI said.

Criminals committed a total of 7,615 hate crimes overall, the data show, including 4,720 directed at people and 2,813 against property. An additional 82 were victims of incidents categorized as “crimes against society,” according to the report.

The FBI report, released Monday morning, found that Anglos comprised the largest percent — 46 percent — of the offenders.

A brother and sister who own a southwest Houston pain clinic and an associate have been charged in a seven-year fraud scheme in which they requested \$9.1 million in reimbursement for false worker compensation claims, according to a news release from the U.S. Attorney’s Office. Anukul “Andy” Dass, 41, and his sister Anurag “Anna” Dass, 46, both of Houston, are due in federal court Thursday before U.S. Magistrate Nancy K. Johnson. Co-defendant Stephen Vincent Hunt, 67, formerly of Houston and now of Waxahachie outside Dallas, turned himself in and made an initial appearance earlier in the week. According to court documents, Anukul and Anurag Dass ran A&A Pain and Wellness Center, Inc. from 2010 to 2017. Prosecutors allege that Hunt, who previously worked for the U.S. Postal Service and was injured, sent postal employees to the pain clinic and the Dasses filed false claims with the Office of Worker Compensation Programs for medical treatment and health care services. Hunt got kickbacks for each claim they filed, according to documents. The scheme billed Workers Compensation more than \$9.1 million in services that were not rendered or necessary. The agency paid the clinic operators \$7.2 million on claims the government alleges are fraudulent. Scott Pierce, Special Agent in Charge at the U.S. Postal Service’s Office of the Inspector General, said pursu-

How to complete a channel scan on your Digital TV to add Channel 15.3

Please note: All TV manufacturers differ, so menu options, wording and other items may vary. The best way to complete the channel scan is to refer to the TV owner's manual. If that is unavailable, the following general steps should guide you through the process.

- 1.Using your television's remote control, press the Menu or Settings option.Note: a "Smart TV" may have a smart button that must be used to access the settings menu. It will generally have the manufacturer's logo on it.
- 2.Locate Channels or Tuner Set Up option.
- 3.Check the menu for an option of Antenna Type or Connection Type followed by either Antenna or Cable.
- 4.Make sure that the designated setting is Cable (based on manufacturer, alternate choices may include Digital Cable, CATV or Cable STD)
- 5.From the menu, choose Digital Channel Search (based on manufacturer,alternate choices may include Channel Scan, Channel Search or Auto program.)
- 6.Allow the TV to complete the search. You will see a bar listing how many channels have been found. The process may take up to an hour.
- 7.Once complete, confirm the menu prompt, then press an exit or quit option.

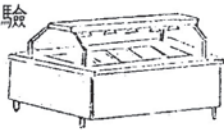
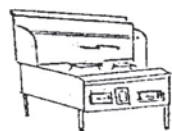

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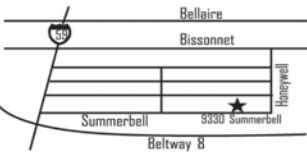
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《雷神3》內地票房破6億蟬聯周冠軍 破《神奇女俠》紀錄 《東方快車謀殺案》首周破億

11月雖然進口片眾多，但並未帶熱內地影市，上周末內地票房僅6.76億，相比上上周7.82億的成績下降13.55%。

新上映的《東方快車謀殺案》沒能撼動《雷神3》的票房霸主地位，後者順利蟬聯周票房冠軍，內地累計票房破6億。《東方快車謀殺案》首周破億，拿下周票房亞軍。《狂獸》、《全球風暴》、《七十七天》位列周票房三四五名。

內地上映次周，《雷神3》再收票房2.71億，蟬聯周票房冠軍，累計票房6.33億。

《雷神》系列前兩部電影此前都曾在內地上映：《雷神》（2011）內地票房9780萬，《雷神2》（2013）內地票房3.42億。《雷神3》目前的成績已經超越該系列前兩部作品的票房總和。

同時，《雷神3》的票房也已經超越今年上映的另壹部超級英雄電影《神奇女俠》（6.1億），本周即有望追上《銀河護衛隊2》6.86億的成績。

上周五《東方快車謀殺案》首映時，《雷神3》曾丟失當天單日票房冠軍的位置，雖然周末重新奪冠，但可以看出票房潛力有限。由於本周五，又壹部超

級英雄電影《正義聯盟》即將登陸內地，《雷神3》的票房無疑會被連壹步分流，最終總票房能否超過今年9月上映的《蜘蛛俠：英雄歸來》（7.74億），懸念不小。根據推理小說大師阿加莎·克裏斯蒂同名小說改編的電影《東方快車謀殺案》上周五內地首映，首周票房1.26億，拿下周票房亞軍。

上周五首映當日，《東方快車謀殺案》曾擊敗《雷神3》，拿下當日票房冠軍。但新鮮勁壹過，周末又被《雷神3》反超。首周破億的成績雖然不算特別亮眼，但相對影片5500萬美元的投資規模

，也還算讓人滿意。

《東方快車謀殺案》在北美同樣於11月10日首映，經粗略統計首周票房2820萬美元，約合1.88億人民幣，大概是內地同期成績的1.5倍。

以目前的票房走勢看，《東方快車謀殺案》內地總票房突破2億難度不大，但若想頂住來自《正義聯盟》的壓力，走得再遠，難度不小。

國產動作電影《狂獸》上周五首映，首周票房4540萬，位居周票房季軍。

《狂獸》由張晉、余文樂、吳越、林家棟等主演，很容易讓人聯想到題材、陣容相近的《殺破狼》系列。不過在票房表現上，《狂獸》與《殺破狼》系列差距頗大。同樣是今年上映的《殺破狼·貪狼》首周票房2.8億（周四首映），總票房5.22億。以目前的票房走勢看，《狂獸》想破億都難度不小。

此前，《狂獸》曾定檔9月15日，後悄然撤檔。這壹略顯“底氣不足”的舉措可能對該片票房產生壹定影響。

災難片《全球風暴》上周再收4000萬票房，位居周票房第四名，累計票房達到4.22億。

野外探險題材的國產電影《七十七天》次周表現優於首周——上周報收3465萬，位居周票房第五名，累計票房4630萬。

郭富城、趙麗穎主演的諜戰題材電影《密戰》上周再收2160萬，累計票房7140萬。《羞羞的鐵拳》上周再收2000萬，累計票房21.94億。

上周新上映的《精靈寶可夢：波爾凱恩恩與機巧的瑪機雅娜》、《天生不對》、《烽火芳菲》、《兄弟，別鬧！》首周票房分別為1510萬、1480萬、1280萬、920萬。《銀翼殺手2049》上周報收315萬，累計票房7600萬。

本周上映的新片有《正義聯盟》、《英雄本色》、《降魔傳》、《恐襲波士頓》等，DC和漫威的超級英雄電影將在內地影市展開正面較量。

傑克布萊克笑稱《雷神3》“抄襲”其創意 聯手“死神海拉”表演齊柏林飛船BGM發起挑戰

事情是這樣的，《雷神3：諸神黃昏》正在全球熱映，齊柏林飛船（Led Zeppelin）經典代表作《移民之歌》Immigrant Song在片中兩次出現，頗受好評。

曾在《搖滾校園》中也用過且“唱過”這首歌的傑克·布萊克不服，開玩笑說《雷神3》偷了他的創意，還用新西蘭/澳大利亞口音提出挑戰，要大戰壹場。

結果他拉來《雷神3》中扮演死神海拉的凱特·布蘭切特在《移民之歌》作為BGM表演慢動作打鬥。因為倆人剛好在拍攝新片《牆上壹個鐘的房子》，該片導演伊萊·羅斯也友情跨刀。

對於傑克布萊克的挑戰，《雷神3》導演塔伊加·維迪提轉發且“艾特”錘哥克裏斯·海姆斯沃斯，希望他出來應戰，目前錘哥暫無回應。

這就是上面這段視頻內容的背景了。

接下來說說這首歌的背景，《移民之歌》（Immigrant Song）在《雷神3》預告中就出現過，傳聞這首歌版權費高達490萬美元，目前影片全球票房6.5億美元，而且除了預告片，正片裏還使用了兩次，妳說這490萬美元花得值不值？

“Immigrant Song”又被譯作異境入侵者之歌，出自1970年齊柏林飛船的第三張專輯《Led Zeppelin III》。漫威也是挺會選歌的，“Immigrant Song”就是壹首基於北歐神話的歌曲，裏面的歌詞說到——

“The hammer of the gods will drive our ships to new lands, to fight the horde, singing and crying: Valhalla, I am coming!（雷神之錘將帶領我們的船只前往新的土地，與部落戰鬥。我們吟唱著，

哭喊著：瓦爾哈拉，我來了）”

此曲的歌詞，再加上布魯斯搖滾那種哀嘆式層層遞進的旋律，顯得和雷神電影系列特別搭。

齊柏林飛船的作品壹向偏向神話主題，像“Ramble On” “Battle of Evermore” “Misty Mountain Hop”則是基於托爾金《魔戒》三部曲的故事。

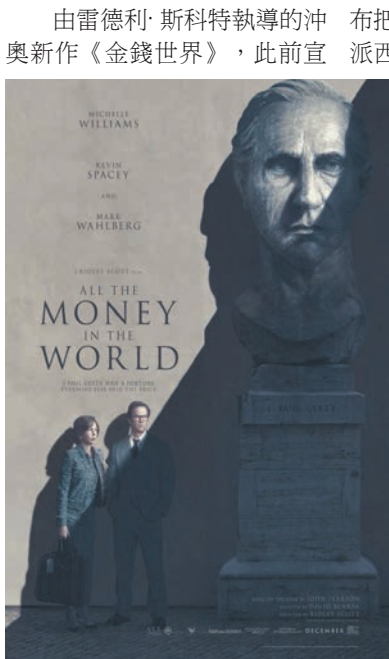
不過“Immigrant Song”的創作背景，比神話故事可要現實多了。主唱羅伯特·普蘭特曾向媒體透露，他們有壹次受邀去冰島做演出，卻遭到了當地民眾遊行反對，官方礙於壓力取消了他們的公演。他們感覺自己就是“異境入侵者”，而“Immigrant Song”就是在說那次巡演經歷。

其實“Immigrant Song”已非第壹次用在電影裏。《搖滾校園》DVD花絮中，主演傑克·布萊克曾聯合所有劇組成員，在鏡頭面前跪求齊柏林飛船授權，可以讓他們在片子裏用Immigrant Song這首歌，因為這部小成本音樂喜劇投資實在太有限，沒法像漫威那樣掏出490萬美元購買。

除此之外，《龍紋身的女孩》《怪物史瑞克3》等電影也有引用這首歌。

此外，齊柏林飛船的其他作品同樣是電影配樂的常客。像大表姐和庫珀的《烏雲背後幸福線》用了“What Is and What Should Never Be”；2012年大本的《逃離德黑蘭》和2015年的《太空頭》都用了“When The Levee Breaks”；而2010年的《鬥士》和2013年的《美國騙局》都用了“Good Times Bad Times”等等。看來，齊柏林飛船才是最大贏家！

《金錢世界》重拍將花費百萬以上 受史派西性醜聞影響 雷德利·斯科特堅持重拍



由雷德利·斯科特執導的沖布把性騷擾醜聞纏身的凱文·史奧新作《金錢世界》，此前宣

派西戲份全部砍掉，並由奧斯卡得主克裏斯托弗·普盧默替代重拍。雷德利·斯科特依然決意要堅持影片此前確定的檔期——12月22日北美開畫，這項決定將使得劇組多花出上百萬美元甚至更高的費用。

距離影片上映只有壹個多的時間再重拍，這是壹個前所未有的大膽決定，多花的上百萬美元，包括後期制作的費用，當然還有不少營銷宣傳的費用——因為要重新制作所有的海報、預告片等等諸多宣傳物料。

據劇組人員透露，重拍凱文·史派西的戲份大概

需要8-10天的時間，這有可能增加高達1000萬美元的預算，拍攝不僅需要替代者克裏斯托弗·普盧默到場，還需要另外兩位主演馬克·沃爾伯格和米歇爾·威廉姆斯也到場，他們兩位也都簽署了重拍的協議。

盡管花費不小，但導演雷德利·斯科特仍然堅持重新拍攝，他認為這是必須要做的事情。凱文·史派西在片中扮演石油大亨保羅·蓋帝，他最近的性騷擾醜聞沸沸揚揚，連Netflix都將他徹底踢出《紙牌屋》。為了最大程度減小凱文·史派西性醜聞對影片帶來的負面影響，並保留沖擊奧斯卡的希望，雷德利·斯科特也不得不走這招險棋。

據內部人士透露，目前還

沒有方法能讓普盧默在綠幕前完成大部分的重拍工作，比如和視效公司合作，將他拼接上原有的素材。

因為斯派西原本拍攝的大部分場景都涉及到與其他演員互動或者單人拍攝，所以導演斯科特和制片人都認為，簡單地重現現場場景會更加經濟和高效。據了解，直接將演員用“摺圖”的數字化方法插入電影，可能會非常難辦，因為很難讓燈光同步。

《金錢世界》真實事件改編，講述前世界首富、石油大亨保羅·蓋帝的孫子遭綁架的故事，原計劃於2017年12月22日上映，重拍工作將在未來兩周內進行，目標是在12月15日之前完成全片。

原班人馬回歸打造的合家歡喜劇《帕丁頓熊2》，今日宣布將於12月8日登陸內地院線，並同時公布兩張中文定檔海報。第壹部《帕丁頓熊》曾在2015年3月在中國內地上映，當時獲得約1億元票房，影片口碑十分出色。

據了解，《帕丁頓熊2》的先期媒體口碑於日前解禁，爛番茄新鮮度100%，12評全鮮，均分高達9.2，而meta評分也達到90，比第壹部評論更優。該片在英國上映首周票房大爆1090萬美元，奪得周末票房冠軍。

在《帕丁頓熊2》中，帕丁頓為了給遠在秘魯的孀孀送上壹份珍貴大禮，帕丁頓決定努力工作，但不想被卷入了壹起寶物失竊案。片中大反派由休·格蘭特飾演，他為了方便作案喬裝了各種造型，報紙上出現的三個嫌疑人都是他假扮的。

該片由前作導演保羅·金執導，本·威士肖（配音）、休·博內威利、莎莉·霍金斯、彼得·卡帕爾蒂、朱莉·沃爾特斯等原班人馬攜手回歸。影片將於2017年11月10日在英國上映，2018年1月12日在北美上映。

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
