China warns U.S. is 'opening fire' on the world with tariff threats

BEIJING (Reuters) - The United States is "opening fire" on the world with its threatened tariffs, China warned on Thursday, saying no one wants a trade war but it will respond the instant U.S. measures go into effect, as Beijing ramped up the rhetoric in the heated dispute.

The Trump administration's tariffs on \$34 billion of Chinese imports are due to go into effect at 0401 GMT on Friday, which is just after midday in Beijing.

U.S. President Donald Trump has threatened to escalate the trade conflict with tariffs on as much as \$450 billion worth of Chinese goods if China retaliates, with the row roiling financial markets including stocks, currencies and the global trade of commodities from soybeans to coal.

China has said it will not "fire the first shot", but its customs agency made clear on Thursday that Chinese tariffs on U.S. goods would take effect immediately after U.S. duties on Chinese goods kick in.

Speaking at a weekly news conference, Commerce Ministry spokesman Gao Feng warned the proposed U.S. tariffs would hit international supply chains, including foreign companies in the world's second-largest economy.

"If the U.S. implements tariffs, they will actually be adding tariffs on companies from all countries, including Chinese and U.S. companies," Gao said.

"U.S. measures are essentially attacking global supply and value chains. To put it simply, the U.S. is opening fire on the entire world, including itself," he said.

"China will not bow down in the face of threats and blackmail and will not falter from its determination to defend free trade and the multilateral system."

Asked whether U.S. companies would be targeted with "qualitative measures" in China in a trade war, Gao said the government would protect the legal rights of all foreign companies in the country.

"We will continue to assess the potential impact of the U.S.-initiated trade war on companies and will help companies mitigate possible shocks."

Gao said China's foreign trade was expected to continue on a stable path in the second half of the year, though investors fear a full-blown Sino-U.S. trade war would deal a body blow to Chinese exports and its economy.

Foreign companies accounted for \$20 billion, or 59 percent, of the \$34 billion of exports from China that will be subject to new U.S. tariffs, with U.S. firms accounting for a significant part of that 59 percent, Gao said.

Speaking at a separate briefing, Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesman Lu Kang sidestepped a question on whether there had been efforts to initiate new talks with the United States."We of course don't want to fight a trade war, but if any country's legitimate interests are harmed, then of course that country has the right to firmly protect their own interests," Lu said.

However, Guo Shuqing, head of China's banking and insurance regulator, said in a statement that the trade war would not affect China's own reforms and opening up, and that it was confident going forward.

"In the past 40 years, the development of China's society and economy has encountered many difficulties and problems, but as long as we uphold the leadership of the Communist Party and reform and opening up, we can surmount all challenges," Guo said in a statement.

trade, a vessel carrying U.S. coal and heading for China was diverted on Wednesday to Singapore. U.S. carmaker Ford Motor Co (F.N) said on Thursday

it has no plans currently to hike retail prices of its imported Ford and Lincoln models in China, despite steep additional tariffs on imported U.S. vehicles set to come into play on Friday.

Ford said it encouraged Washington and Beijing to resolve their issues over trade and that it would "continue to monitor the situation as it evolves".

The World Trade Organization warned on Wednesday that trade barriers being erected by major economies could jeopardize the global economic recovery, with their effects already starting to show.

Adding to the tensions, a Chinese court this week temporarily barred Micron Technology Inc (MU.O) from selling its main semiconductor products in the world's biggest memory chip market, citing violation of patents held by Taiwan's United Microelectronics Corp (UMC) (2303.TW).

Beijing has made the semiconductor sector a key priority under its "Made in China 2025" strategy, which has shifted up a gear after a U.S. ban on sales to Chinese phone maker ZTE Corp (000063.SZ) underscored China's lack of domestic chips.

Chinese stocks slipped on Thursday and the yuan steadied from earlier losses as a targeted cut of reserve requirements for banks took effect amid the heightened trade tensions.

How victims, local officials and an aloof FEMA put flooded homes back in harm's way


Officials in Houston and across the country are failing to enforce a central pillar of the taxpayer-subsidized National Flood Insurance Program: Making sure severely damaged properties are elevated or removed from flood plains.

Thousands of such homes get rebuilt and then flood again, often for more than they are worth, costing taxpayers more than \$1 billion in repeat losses.

One of the nation's worst properties in this regard, a house on the San Jacinto River in Kingwood, has had 22 flood insurance claims totaling more than \$2.5 million since 1979. That's at least eight times what the house is worth, according to the data. The deeply indebted program is set to lapse July 31 without congressional reauthorization, and lawmakers have put forward a host of potential reforms to tie to that vote, but none directly address the costly problem of poorly enforced elevation requirements.

Texas has more flooded properties with evidence of this problem than any other state but Louisiana; Houston has more than any other city, a Houston Chronicle investigation found. Seven of the nation's 10 most frequently substantially damaged properties are in Houston. Those seven have had 107 damage claims totaling \$9 million, even though the combined value of those buildings is just \$426,000. Under federal rules, local officials are supposed to assess flood damages and require demolition or elevation if the damage is estimated at 50 percent or more of the home's

The Chronicle examined claims records for more than 36,000 "severe repetitive loss" properties – the most frequently flooded properties in the flood insurance program nationwide. About 16 percent had evidence of being substantially damaged – beyond the 50 percent threshold – at least once before flooding again. This data suggests their damage assessments were too low or not enforced.


almost whimsical silhouette at the piano. I am a bit of a dreamer, so I like to create a bit of fantasy for myself and my audience."


Canada has begun imposing tariffs on \$12.6 billion in U.S. goods as retaliation for the Trump administration's new taxes on steel and aluminum imported to the United States. The tariffs went into effect last Sunday. Prime Minister Justin Trudeau's government released on Friday the full list of items that Canada is targeting. Some U.S. products, mostly steel and iron, face 25 percent tariffs, the same penalty the United States slapped on imported steel at the end of May. Other U.S. imports, from ketchup to pizza to dishwasher detergent, will face a 10 percent tariff at the Canadian border, the same as America's tax on imported aluminum.

President Donald Trump infuriated U.S. allies -- from Canada to Mexico and the European Union -- by imposing tariffs of 25 percent on imported steel and 10 percent on aluminum. Canadian Foreign Minister Chrystia Freeland said Friday they had no other choice and will not escalate the dispute, but also will not back down. She called the tariffs regrettable.

Trudeau on Sunday spoke in Leamington, Ontario, where he thanked Canadians for standing united against President Donald Trump's sanctions. He urged Canadians to "make their choices accordingly" in considering whether to buy American prod-

Congressman AI Green's Statement on the Separation of Migrant Families at the United States Border

(Houston, TX) - Congressman Al Green traveled to a childcare detention facility in Brownsville, Texas, on Monday, July 2, 2018 to investigate the humanitarian crisis created by President Trump. He released the following statement ding the intentional separation of migrant families by the government at the border

"Young children should not be ripped from the arms of parents fleeing harm and seeking asylum. Children are held at Southwest Key Casa El Presidente, one of many childcare detention facilities, while their parents are detained in different facilities. There, the parents wait for an indefinite amount of time for a judge to evaluate their case. Many of these children are at a tender age, younger than 5, and are susceptible to psychological damage that could follow them for years. These families need to be reunited to protect the wellbeing of these vulnerable children.

"I am publicly calling on the Trump Administration to fully right this wrong and reunite 100% of children separated from their families by the government at the border. This is not a partisan issue. This is a human rights issue. You do not have to be a parent to sympathize. You only have to be human. America, the home of liberty and justice for all, should not give the rest of the world the impression that we have no regard for the mental and physical wellbeing of migrant families fleeing harm. The nightmare of potentially losing your child forever has become the harsh reality for too many parents. We cannot stand idly by and allow this to conti


