Trump gets a U.S. Supreme Court victory on immigration detention

WASHINGTON (Reuters) - The Supreme Court on Tuesday endorsed the U.S. government's authority to detain immigrants awaiting deportation anytime - potentially even years - after they have completed prison terms for criminal convictions, handing President Donald Trump a victory as he pursues hardline immigration policies. The court ruled 5-4 along ideological lines, with its conservative justices in the majority and its liberal justices dissenting, that federal authorities could pick up such immigrants and place them into indefinite detention anytime, not just immediately after they finish prison sentences.

The ruling, authored by conservative Justice Samuel Alito, left open the possibility that some immigrants could challenge their detention. These immigrants potentially could argue that the use of the 1996 federal law involved in the case, the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act, against them long after finishing their sentences would violate their due process rights under the U.S. Constitution.

Most of the plaintiffs in the case are legal immigrants.

The law states the government can detain convicted immigrants "when thealien is released" from criminal detention. Civil rights lawyers in the case argued that the language of the law shows that it applies only immediately after immigrants are released. The Trump administration said the government should have the power to detain such immigrants anytime.

In dissent, liberal Justice Stephen Breyer said the ruling raises serious due process questions.

"It runs the gravest risk of depriving those whom the government has detained of one of the oldest and most important of our constitutionally guaranteed freedoms," Breyer wrote.

But Alito wrote that it is not the court's job to impose a time limit for when immigrants can be detained after serving a prison sentence. Alito noted that the court has previously said that "an official's crucial duties are better carried

# yft's IPO already oversubscribed - sources

NEW YORK (Reuters) - Lyft Inc's initial public offering (IPO) is oversubscribed based on commitments made so far by investors, making it more likely that the ride-hailing startup will fetch or even exceed the \$23 billion valuation it is seeking, people familiar with the matter said on Tuesday.

Lyft started its IPO road show on Monday and has spent the last two days meeting with investors in New York, the sources said. It has set an indicative IPO price range of \$62 to \$68 per share and is set to price the IPO on March 28.

The exact level of oversubscription could not be learned. The sources cautioned that the IPO price is still uncertain and asked not to be identified because the matter is confidential.

Lyft declined to comment.

# Bernie Sanders hires Beto O'Rourke critic as top aide in 2020 race

WASHINGTON (Reuters) - U.S. Senator Bernie Sanders on Tuesday said he is hiring a well-known liberal journalist with a history of sharply criticizing other Democratic presidential candidates, including Beto O'Rourke.

Sanders' campaign said it is bringing in David Sirota, whose work has appeared in The Guardian and Newsweek, among other outlets, as a senior adviser and speechwriter.

The move could stoke tensions within the Democratic field since Sirota has previously targeted O'Rourke, a former U.S. congressman from Texas who entered the presidential race last week, and other rivals.

Sirota on Twitter and in published articles has accused O'Rourke of siding with President Donald Trump and Republicans while a member of the House of Representatives, as well as being overly friendly with the oil and gas industry.

Sirota's criticism of O'Rourke in December drew a warning from Neera Tanden, a top ally of former presidential candidate Hillary Clinton and president of the Center for American Progress, a Democratic think tank.

"A supporter of Bernie Sanders attacking a Democrat," Tanden tweeted. "This is seriously dangerous. We know Trump is in the White House and attacking Dems is doing Trump's bidding." The conflict was a reminder of the bad blood between the Clinton and Sanders camps when they battled for the Democratic nomination ahead of the 2016 presidential race and the mistrust between the party's moderate and progressive

Sirota also has slammed presidential candidates Cory Booker, Kirsten Gillibrand and Kamala Harris, as well as former U.S. Vice President Joe Biden, for being overly cozy with corporate

interests.

Sanders' campaign did not respond to a request for comment on Sirota's hiring.
Sirota worked for Sanders as a press secretary when Sanders was a member of the House of Representatives in the early 2000s.

Sen. Warren tests 2020 message in deep South An article Sirota wrote in 2013 for the liberal news website Salon praising the economic record of Hugo Chavez, Venezuela's late socialist president, also attracted criticism on social media from Sanders' Democratic Party critics and conservatives alike.

Sanders recently refused to label Venezuela's current president, Nicolas Maduro, a dictator or recognize the opposition leader, Juan Guaido, as the country's rightful leader - the current U.S. position.

Guaido invoked the constitution to assume the interim presidency in January, saying Maduro's re-election was not legitimate.





# Walmart Out To Fix Health Care, Now Flies **Employees To Top Hospitals For Treatment**

### **OVERVIEW**

Walmart shared a case-study this week on its efforts to improve health care for its employees. It described how a patient got an all expenses paid trip to Geisinger Medical Center in Pennsylvania with his wife to get a second opinion on whether he needed spine surgery. The employee, in fact, had Parkinson's Disease. The decision saved Walmart \$30,000 by averting the procedure.

Case Study: "Bill," an employee at Walmart, had been suffering from mild neck pain and a tremor in his hands. A local surgeon recommended spine surgery as the next course of action.

Walmart decided to send him and his wife on a flight to a hospital in another state, all expenses paid, so he could get a second opinion. He saw a team of clinicians at Geisinger Medical Center, a top hospital system in Pennsylvania. They noticed a subtle shuffle in his step and diagnosed him with Parkinson's Disease.

The employee avoided a painful, expensive surgery that he did not need. Walmart (which is self-insured) saved about \$30,000 it would have paid for that surgery, and it also benefited when he went back to work after his symptoms improved. Geisinger got

paid for the consult. In the end, Bill's story, which both Geising-

er and Walmart shared this week with

permission, was a win for everyone. (The

study used "Bill" as a pseudonym to protect



But it also speaks to a larger trend: U.S. employers are getting increasingly fed up with the myriad problems with the U.S. medical system. Companies pay for about 49 percent of Americans' health care, and are facing rising costs without any real improvements in outcomes.

So Walmart and its partners published a case study detailing their approach in Harvard Business Review, in an effort to disseminate its ideas more broadly.

Walmart's Lisa Woods, who wrote the piece with Jonathan Slotkin, a director of spine surgery at Geisinger, and Ruth Coleman, a health executive and nurse, described how they've succeeded by focusing on more than just lowering costs. They also looked for ways to improve overall health outcomes for their workers, so they could return to work, including by offering travel programs for workers to see doctors at top hospitals who were not incentivized to push for an unnecessary surgery.

### 'Skinnin' us alive'

Walmart is not the only employer advocating for change.

Berkshire Hathaway's Warren Buffett, who formed an alliance with J.P. Morgan CEO Jamie Dimon and Amazon's Jeff Bezos, has described health care as the "hungry tapeworm on the American economy." The trio of executives formed a nonprofit company in 2018, called Haven, to figure out how to stem health costs with technology.

Walmart, which also offers pharmacy service and health clinics, has been aware of the problem for much longer than that. The Harvard Business Review piece noted that its founder Sam Walton in a meeting with senior leaders almost thirty years ago described health care as "skinnin' us alive" He went on: "if we don't get it done this year, I'm gonna get real upset. I mean real upset."





The company's Centers of Excellence program, which requires its employees to use a curated list of hospitals for some surgeries, has been in place for about six years. (It was optional until 2018.)

It started with a relationship with Mayo Clinic, but Walmart has been forming these arrangements with other health centers including Geisinger. Spine surgeries were an early focus, as they are expensive and often unnecessary.

Sometimes, these hospitals will agree with the community physician and recommend surgery. But they'll often diagnose the patient with a different condition, like Bill, or they recommend physical therapy or other less invasive options instead.

Walmart employees also get their travel paid for to get second opinions on cancer diagnoses and heart surgeries.

# The Clinic



At the heart of the program is an idea that health care incentives need to change. Rather than paying health providers for performing procedures and tests. Walmart rewards them for overall health outcomes.

And it's going well, so much so that Walmart wants to encourage other employers to follow its lead. And Geisinger said wants to make the program available to smaller employers, including mid-sized companies.

"This has been a journey we've been on for several years," said Woods, a senior director in Walmart's benefits department, in an interview with CNBC. "We're committed to sharing what we learn." (Courtesy https://www.cnbc.com)



"That's where we're going now: full primary care services in five to seven years."

After Walmart spent years hosting retail primary care clinics through leases with local hospitals, the corporation opened its first fully-owned retail Care Clinics in 2014 in South Carolina, Georgia, and Texas.

Walmart's corporate strategy is centered on cost management and distribution efficiency. Walmart's footprint allowed it to capitalize on a retail clinic market without a first-mover advantage, and pick geographical areas where it could offer a compelling, familiar consumer experience to address a bottleneck in access to health care, cost



Out of pocket cost of services is the largest barrier to access to health care in South Carolina, Georgia, and Texas, which has

been compounded by each state's failure to expand Medicaid enrollment to individuals and families with incomes above the federal poverty line. The result is a rising wave of consumers who are increasingly price-sensitive to the cost of health care.

### Approximately 40% of the patients seen at Walmart's clinics don't have a primary care provider.

Walmart made waves when it set prices for some generic prescription drugs to just \$4 in 2008. When their Care Clinics launched in 2014, office visits cost \$40, and just \$4 for Walmart employees and family members on the company's insurance plan. A pregnancy test costs \$3 and a cholesterol test costs \$8.

The largest contributor to operating expenses for a traditional primary care clinic is headcount. Like other retail clinics before them, Walmart is able to charge lower prices per-service because they can deliver them on lower operating expenses. Each retail clinic is staffed by nurse practitioners, who each command less than half of a physician salary

Today, Walmart has pharmacies in most of its 5000+ stores and Sam Club brands, and in-store clinics in the same three states, Georgia, South Carolina, and Texas. Notably, these three states are all markets with a higher number of uninsured or underinsured patients, have a high burden of chronic disease, and all house a large number of Walmart employees.

That being said, when compared to market leader MinuteClinic, owned by CVS Caremark, Walmart's retail clinic strategy to date hasn't been particularly impressive, they run only 19 company-owned Care Clinics versus the 1,100 MinuteClinics in CVS and Target stores. However, a potential merger or partnership with Humana and the resulting changes in financial incentives makes rapid expansion of Walmart's retail clinic and insurance presence a more compelling corporate strategy.

### Walmart Health 2.0

The Walmart-Humana strategy roadmap is as follows:

- 1. Capture the rapidly growing Medicare Advantage market
- 2. Cross the chasm into the commercial employer-sponsored insurance market

# TRUMP SIGNS LARGEST WILDERNESS PROTECTION BILL **IN DECADE, DESIGNATES 375,000 NEW ACRES OF PROTECTED LAND**

President Donald Trump signed the country's largest wilderness preservation legislation in a decade, providing widespread protections for Joshua Tree and Death Valley national parks.

Trump's signing of the National Resources Management Act, or S.47, marked a surprisingly overwhelming bipartisan congressional effort and began with the environmental protection bill introduced by Alaska Republican Senator Lisa Murkowski in January. The bill expands federally protected land, where there can be no logging, drilling, mining or road construction, and establishes 375,000 new acres of wilderness across California, Oregon, New Mexico and Utah. The bill passed the Senate with a vote of 92-8 and the House with a vote of 362-63.

In another rare turn of events, the White

House did not issue a statement or remarks from Trump after he signed the bill into law Tuesday. Murkowski posted a video to Twitter showing Trump gifting her office with the Sharpie pen he used to sign the legislation.

The legislation creates recreational benefits and added security to visitors and explorers of the national parks through the facilitation of biking, hiking and numer-



"We built it through a team effort that drew strong support from both parties in both chambers. Today is a triumph for good process and good policy, and this bill is a win for Alaskans and all Americans," Murkowski tweeted Tuesday, lauding the bipartisan effort in Congress to pass the bill with overwhelming numbers. She noted Washington Democratic Senator Maria Cantwell worked with her on the lands package bill for several years.

The bill, the "John D. Dingell Jr. Conservation, Management, and Recreation Act," is the most encompassing federal wilderness law passed in the U.S. since March 2009. At that time, President Barack Obama signed legislation which designated 2 million acres of new protected wilderness across the Sierra Nevada and California desert regions.

The lands package bill included the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act, which protects 30,000 acres of old-growth rainforest and 250 miles of waterways along Oregon's

The bill was touted by Mojave Desert conservationists and also created a new national monument in honor of 431 people who were killed during the 1928 collapse of the St. Francis Dam near Santa Clarita, California, close to Los Angeles.

But Trump's signing of the bill was partially overshadowed by environmentalist groups angered that his proposed federal budget cuts funding by 31 percent for the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, or EPA. His proposed budget also reduces funding for the U.S. Department of the Interior by 14 percent and completely eliminates a \$7,500 tax credit given to owners of electric vehicles. Additionally, the president named a former coal lobbyist, Andrew Wheeler, as head of the EPA. (Courtesy newsweek.com.)

est Wilderness Preservation Bill in Ten

President Donald Trump this week signed a massive wilderness preservation bill that sets aside 1.3 million acres of federal land in California, Oregon, Utah and New Mexico as wilderness. Land designed as wilderness cannot be used for logging, oil drilling or mining.



"This law will give countless Americans the chance to enjoy the natural wonders of our country as we uphold our responsibility to protect the beauty and glory of God's creation for generations to come," Trump said, according to the Victorville Daily Press.

The bill creates 375,000 acres of wilderness in the Mojave Desert, according to San Jose's The Mercury News.

The bill expands Death Valley National Park by 35,929 acres and Joshua Tree National Park by 4,518 acres.

Geary Hund, executive director of the Joshua Tree-based Mojave Desert Land Trust, called the action a "huge win for conservation."


"It ensures that some of the most important natural and cultural resources in the Mojave Desert will be protected and connected in perpetuity," Hund said in a statement.

Hund said the areas that are targeted are "critically important" to desert ecosystems and "iconic desert species," such as the desert tortoise and bighorn sheep.

The "John D. Dingell Jr. Conservation, Management, and Recreation Act," is a collection of Republican and Democratic proposals, including those to expand protection for various rivers, establish new Civil War monuments in Kentucky and in Mississippi and honor civil rights leaders Medgar and Myrlie Evers.

The bill will also permanently reauthorize the Land and Water Conservation Fund, which is used to fund parks and outdoor recreational amenities.





【編者按】本文李毅先生2019年2月23日在美國紐約法拉盛爲中國戰略分析智庫所作的台灣問題演講,題爲《李毅:北平 方式統一台灣一國兩制台灣方案》。現爲本報轉載。

【提要】台灣當局永遠也不來與大陸談判統一,台灣問題要無限期拖下去,台灣問題要一代一代傳下去。現在,大陸14 億人,台灣島2300萬人,大陸經濟總量是台灣的22倍,軍費是台灣的15倍,外匯儲備是台灣的7倍,大陸三天就可以拿下台灣 ,從大約2012年後,美日海空軍已經無法介入台海戰事。統一台灣,治理台灣,建設台灣,易如反掌,全在大陸戰略規劃的一 念之間,只差一個韓先楚。和平統一,一國兩制,對各方都有利。鑑於獨派、天然獨在台灣天天壯大,統派在台灣日漸衰亡, 實現和平統一、一國兩制的有效辦法,可以是:北平方式,統一台灣。最多五年之後,大陸就有條件從容解決台灣問題。一國 兩制的台灣方案,究竟是個什麼樣子,台灣人民很想知道,現在亟需公示。

中國至今沒有統一,是國家之痛,民族之痛。 1840年後,中國百年國恥,台灣問題,始於甲午戰爭,馬關條約,日本割走 中國台灣省,目前,中國唯一沒有洗去的百年國恥,就是中國台灣省還沒有統一。今天中國作爲世界產值第二、世界軍費第二 的大國,作爲聯合國五大常任理事國之一,居然連自己的國家統一問題都沒有解決,這是中華民族的恥辱,中國國家的恥辱, 中國軍隊的恥辱。

### 第一部分,介紹習總講話。

習總今年1月2日,再次完整宣示大陸的對台政策。說中國必須統一、必然統一。說兩岸制度不同,不妨礙統一。說一國兩 制,會全力照顧台灣。習總說九二共識就是 "海峽兩岸同屬一個中國,共同努力謀求國家統一",這是撥亂反正、正本淸源。 以前大陸講,九二共識就是兩岸同屬一個中國,這個講法有些片面。九二共識是兩句話,第一句是,兩岸同屬一個中國,但這 句話只是個前提,只是個引子,第二句才是實質,努力謀求中國統一。所以,只承認兩岸同屬一個中國,不是九二共識。承認 兩岸同屬一中,謀求國家統一,也不完全是九二共識。努力謀求國家統一,才是九二共識,不努力不行。習總鄭重倡議,兩岸 <sup>台湾民众的认同(受访者占比%)</sup> 就一國兩制的台灣方案,展開協商

對於大陸上述鄭重宣示,台灣各黨各派立場堅定、旗幟鮮明。蔡英文、民進黨立即表示堅決反對。國民黨明星立委、蔣介 石曾孫蔣万安,力挺蔡英文。國民黨立院黨團總召江啓臣等國民黨青壯派,傾向蔣万安。國民黨中央發表六點回應:反對台獨 ,反對統一,否定一國兩制,承認九二共識但堅決不說兩岸同屬一個中國,這基本上代表了吳敦義、朱立倫、王金平、馬英九 的立場。柯文哲迴避獨統問題,說兩岸一家親,實際上反對統一。韓國瑜,說九二共識是兩岸互動的定海神針,但不說兩岸同 屬一個中國,更不說贊成統一。洪秀柱支持統一,反對台獨,但不講支持一國兩制。完全贊同和平統一、一國兩制的有:許立 農上將,新黨鬱慕明,中華統一促進黨張安樂。這些回應,都在意料之中,是台灣選民現在獨統傾向的眞實寫照。

針對台灣各方的回應,1月9日,大陸國務院新聞辦公室,召開記者會,請何雷中將解讀習總講話。《何雷中將:大陸武 統台灣日,嚴懲台獨戰犯時》,見互聯網。美日歐媒體,都紛紛報導了何雷中將的學習體會

習總的講話,何雷中將對習總講話的學習體會,短短50天,產生了巨大的效果,最近幾天,兩岸形勢發生變化,張亞中、 王金平、吳敦義、朱立倫,紛紛表示,如果國民黨2020年1月贏得選舉,可以考慮簽訂兩岸和平協定。 第二部分,回顧70年來,大陸統一台灣工作的歷史。

大陸本擬在1950年8月解放台灣,粟裕攻台、舒同管台準備大體完成,但此前一個多月,朝鮮內戰1950年6月25日爆發, 美國第七艦隊次日進入台灣海峽。早知道,大陸提前兩個月進攻,現在就沒有台灣問題了。幸虧韓先楚力排衆議,1950年5月 初提前攻占海南島,要不然現在中國連海南省都沒有了。大陸被迫於1950年10月發動抗美援朝戰爭,40天拿下平壤,70天拿 下漢城,從鴨綠江打過三八線,一雪中華民族百年國恥,中國人民從此站立起來了。

因爲美國海空軍當時太強大,大陸海空軍當時太弱小,毛澤東改用和平方式統一台灣,經過與蔣介石十年周旋,1965年與 蔣介石初步達成和平統一台灣六項協定:1、蔣介石偕同舊部回到大陸,定居在浙江以外的任何省區,仍任國民黨總裁。北京 撥出江西廬山為蔣介石居住與辦公處所。 2、蔣經國任台灣省省長。台灣除交出外交與軍事外,北京只堅持農業方面"耕者有 其田",其他"內政"完全由台灣省政府全權處理。 3、台灣不得接受外國任何軍事與經濟援助;財政上有困難,由北京照美 國支援數額照撥補助。 4、台灣海、空軍併入北京控制。陸軍縮編爲四個師,其中一個師駐在廈門、金門地區,三個師駐在台 灣。 5、廈門與金門合併爲一個自由市,作爲北京與台北間的緩衝與聯絡地區。該市市長由國民黨駐軍師長兼任。 6、台灣現 任文武百官的官階、待遇照舊不變。台灣人民生活保證只可提高,不可降低

可惜因爲大陸1966年發生文革,未能實現。 1975年,毛澤東、蔣介石重啓統一進程,可惜1976年兩人都去世了。鄧小平 提出八十年代三大任務:發展經濟,聯合反霸,解決台灣問題。和平統一,一國兩制,台灣保留軍隊,國名、國旗、國歌可以 商量,等等。實際上,鄧小平,是把毛澤東開給蔣介石的六項條件,更加優惠,公開說給蔣經國。鄧小平和蔣經國在莫斯科是 同班同學,現在有人寫文章說,不僅是同班,還曾經同桌。鄧小平說八十年代要解決台灣問題,可能有很確切的根據,只是現 在,對當時鄧小平與蔣經國之間的聯繫與協商,還沒有解密。蔣經國要是晚死上幾年,台灣和平統一,或許可能實現。蔣經國 犯了兩個大錯誤,第一是不知道自己很快要死,第二是有意無意選李登輝做了接班人。

蔣經國1988年逝世。李登輝接班。李登輝是潛伏的台獨領袖,有高度的政治智慧和堅定靈活的執行力。三十年來,在李登 輝、陳水扁、蔡英文等台獨領袖的領導下,台獨事業,不斷發展,從無到有,從小到大,從弱到強,不斷發展壯大。與此同時 ,統一勢力,在台灣,逐步消亡。(未完待續)


# 台灣人民族認同的長期趨勢圖 [1991~2018]
