## Chinese envoy asks for robust Security Council actions to address Palestinian-Israeli issue

UNITED NATIONS, May 27 (Xinhua) -- A Chinese envoy on Thursday asked for robust actions of the Security Council to address the Palestinian-Israeli issue.

“The Security Council bears the primary responsibility for the maintenance of international peace and security, and as such, must take robust actions to address the Palestinian-Israeli issue and reaffirm its unwavering support for a two-state solution,” said Zhang Jun, China’s permanent representative to the United Nations.

The Palestinian-Israeli issue has been on the UN agenda for more than 70 years. Each time the Palestinian-Israeli situation is thrown into turmoil, it serves as an alarm bell for international rule of law, weighs on human conscience, and tests the effectiveness of multilateral mechanisms, he told the Security Council.

“The latest round of conflict reminds us, once again, that we cannot afford to allow the Middle East process to go off the rails, or to push the question of Palestine to the margins, or to overlook the suffering of the Palestinian people and their well-deserved rights, or to forget the many binding resolutions adopted by the Security Council, or to shirk the responsibility the Security Council must undertake,” he said.

As Chinese State Councilor and Foreign Minister Wang Yi pointed out at the May 16 Security Council emergency meeting, an enduring settlement can only be achieved on the basis of a two-state solution. Only when the question of Palestine is resolved in a comprehensive, just and sustainable way, can lasting peace and security for all be truly achieved in the Middle East, said Zhang.

“We must push the two parties to relaunch equal-footed dialogue at an early date to rebuild trust, overcome their differences, and find a way to live in peace side by side. The international community, especially countries with influence on Palestine and Israel, must take an objective and impartial position and work hard to facilitate the Middle East peace process while enhancing international coordination and strengthening the synergy for peace,” he said.

Fragilities persist on the ground despite the cease-fire. The international community must step up efforts to ensure that the parties concerned respect the cease-fire in good faith in the interests of restoring calm as soon as possible, he said.

Renewed confrontation in and outside Al-Aqsa Mosque last weekend point to continued tensions in East Jerusalem. China, once again, urges all parties concerned to exercise restraint and refrain from any moves that may escalate the situation. Israel must genuinely put an end to violence, threats, and provocations against the Muslim community, maintain and respect the historical and present status quo of the holy sites in Jerusalem, stop evicting Palestinian people and halt all settlement activities, he said.

The humanitarian crisis in the occupied Palestinian territory is concerning. In Gaza, years of blockade, COVID-19 and now over 10 days of clashes and turmoil have conspired to plunge the residents of Gaza -- over 2 million of them -- in dire straits, said Zhang.

“We call on the international community to act without delay and provide humanitarian assistance to Palestine through multiple channels and emergency funding support to the UN Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA). We call on Israel to facilitate humanitarian access and completely lift the blockade on Gaza as soon as possible.”

China will send 1 million U.S. dollars in cash to Palestine as emergency humanitarian aid, donate another 1 million dollars to UNRWA and 200,000 doses of COVID-19 vaccine. China will continue to do whatever it can to help the Palestinian people in ways that address their practical needs, he said.

# UN top envoy in Somalia welcomes deal by Somali leaders to hold elections in 60 days

MOGADISHU, May 28 (Xinhua) -- The United Nations top envoy in Somalia on Friday welcomed the decision reached by Somali leaders to hold presidential and parliamentary elections within two months following four days of intense negotiations in Mogadishu.

James Swan, UN Secretary-General's Special Representative for Somalia, urged all stakeholders to move forward swiftly in the same spirit of compromise and cooperation to implement the agreement.

"We further encourage the federal government and federal member states' leaders to continue regular consultations throughout the electoral process to ensure that any emerging disputes can be resolved quickly," Swan said in a statement issued in Mogadishu.

On Thursday, Somalia's Prime Minister Mohamed Hussein Roble and leaders of five federal member states, alongside governor of Banadir Regional Administration, agreed that the process to elect the president and members of parliament would be completed in 60 days.

The electoral committee will issue a timetable agreed upon by the federal and state-level electoral implementation teams.

The leaders resolved that the consultative council of leaders will be responsible for the electoral process and resolve any issues that arise.

A communique was issued on Thursday with key resolutions on the formation of electoral committees at the federal and state levels, management of the Somaliland election committee management, resolving election and security issues in Gedo region, implementation of the women's quota and the release of the elections timetable and completion of the roadmap to state-building.

The communique gave a timeframe of two years to resolve outstanding issues that include finalizing the federal constitution, resource-sharing, defining the powers of federal institutions, restructuring of security forces, reaching an agreement on the model of dialogue with Somaliland, and establishing enabling conditions for the implementation of the one-person, one-vote elections.

The communique also stated that Prime Minister Roble would lead the process of appointing members of the Federal Electoral Implementation Team and the State Electoral Implementation Team.



## Palestine condemns Israel's settlement expansion plan

RAMALLAH, May 28 (Xinhua) -- The Palestinian Ministry of Foreign Affairs on Friday condemned Israel's settlement expansion, saying that the Israeli authorities recently approved the construction of 560 new settlement units south of the West Bank city of Bethlehem.

"Construction of new units aims at expanding the settlements that were built on Palestinian citizens' lands in the area," the ministry said in a statement sent to Xinhua.

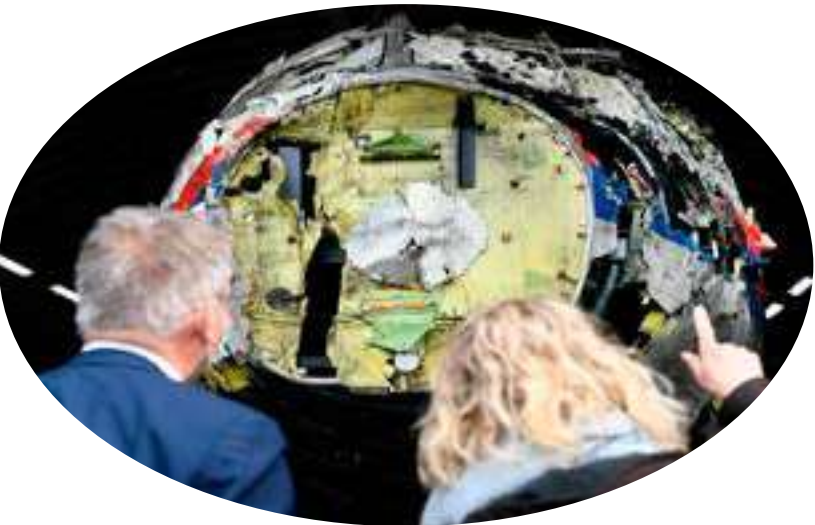
The statement warned that the expansion of settlements in the area of Bethlehem in the West Bank "will isolate Palestinian towns and villages from each other and turn them into isolated islands in an ocean of settlements."

The foreign ministry's statement held the Israeli government responsible for the settlement expansion and the seizing of Palestinian lands, and warned of its disastrous consequences for the chances of making peace

Half Of All U.S. Adults Are Now Fully Vaccinated Against COVID-19

As of 19 May, around 37% of the US population has been fully vaccinated and about 60% of adults over 18 had gotten their first jab. The CDC’s advisory came after around half of Americans received their first jab, and as vaccinations opened up to children as young as 12. The U.S. COVID-19 vaccination program has gone from zero to 50% in less than six months.

As of Tuesday afternoon, the Biden administration said, half of the country’s adults are now fully vaccinated against the coronavirus.

“This is a major milestone in our country’s vaccination efforts,” Andy Slavitt, a White House senior adviser on the COVID-19 response, said during a midday briefing. “The number was 1% when we entered office Jan. 20.”

Nearly 130 million people age 18 and older have completed their vaccine regimens since the first doses were administered to

the public in December, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention said. Another 70 million vaccine doses are currently in the distribution pipeline, according to the agency.

Vaccinations have risen sharply in children 12 years and older, weeks after the Food and Drug Administration said that cohort is eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine made by Pfizer-BioNTech. Nearly 5 million adolescents have received at least one dose of the vaccine, according to the CDC’s latest data.



Anti-mask protests have been taking place across the country. When nine

fully vaccinated baseball players for the New York Yankees tested positive for Covid, CDC director Dr Rochelle Walensky said the fact that only two experienced mild symptoms showed “this is the vaccine working”.

The U.S. is pushing to add millions more people to the ranks of the vaccinated. President Biden said this month that his new goal is to administer at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine to 70% of U.S. adults by the Fourth of July. Nine states have given at least one vaccine shot to 70% of their adult population, Slavitt said at Tuesday’s briefing. Acknowledging the welcome return to a more normal life taking place around the country, he urged more people to get the vaccine: “Unless you’re vaccinated, you’re at risk.”

An increasing number of states, businesses and organizations are offering incentives for people to get vaccinated, from free doughnuts to free airline flights. One of the best-known programs is in Ohio, where people who get vaccinated are entered into a \$1 million lottery called the Ohio Vax-a-Million. “Gov. Mike DeWine has unlocked a secret,” Slavitt said, noting that Ohio’s vaccination rate went up 55% among young adults in the days after unveiling the program. Other states have since announced similar plans.



The stunning speed of the vaccines’ development and rollout has helped tame COVID-19 in the U.S., which remains the worst-hit country in the world, despite having less than 5% of the world’s population. The U.S. has reported more than 33 million COVID-19 cases, and more than 590,000 people have died from the disease.

Vaccination rates vary sharply across the nation. On the state level, more than half of all adults were fully vaccinated in just

25 states, along with the District of Columbia and Guam, as [NPR’s Laurel Wamsley reported](#).

The lowest overall vaccination rates in the U.S. remain in the South, where Mississippi, Alabama, Louisiana and Arkansas have administered the fewest doses per 100,000 adults, according to the CDC. The highest rates are in Vermont, Massachusetts, Hawaii and Connecticut.

Pfizer and BioNTech’s vaccine is the most prevalent in the U.S., with more than 155 million doses administered, the CDC said. Moderna is next, with nearly 122 million doses. Johnson & Johnson, whose one-dose vaccine was approved after the two messenger RNA vaccines, accounts for more than 10 million doses. (Courtesy npr.org)

‘No Masks For The Vaccinated’: What The Latest U.S. Mask Guidance Means



US health officials have announced that vaccinated Americans no longer need to wear masks or social distance in most indoor settings - but many Americans remain confused as Covid-19 rules just became more complicated.

Last week, the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) [changed their guidance on face masks](#), saying that fully vaccinated people no longer need them in most places.

It comes just over a year since the CDC first recommended that Americans cover their face and nose when in public and as new case weekly averages fall to lows not seen since last summer.

So far, nearly two dozen states, including the former global hot spot of New York, have started to change their virus mitigation rules to reflect the new CDC guidance. Here’s what the latest changes mean.

How will we know who is vaccinated?

We won’t.

According to the CDC, people who have

gone two weeks since their final Covid vaccine jab no longer need to wear masks except in healthcare, prison or transportation settings. Physical distancing also is no longer necessary for the fully vaccinated. But there’s no way to know whether the mask-less shopper in your local supermarket aisle is fully vaccinated or choosing to forgo a mask for another reason.

Who can require proof of vaccination?

US officials have dismissed the idea of a “vaccine passport” to prove a person’s job history, saying it represents a violation of privacy.

That shifts the burden to local governments and businesses to determine whether to require proof of vaccination.

Already, several major businesses, including Walmart and Target, have been allowing shoppers to go unmasked without declaring their vaccination status.

But some concerts and other large gatherings have asked attendees for proof. Health experts warn that the black market for fake vaccination cards will balloon in the next few months.

Why did the CDC change the guidelines?

“I think the CDC realised that if they don’t do something that sounds reasonable to people, then they’ve kind of lost the influence that the rules make sense,” says Dr Gabor Kelen, director of the emergency medicine department at Johns Hopkins University. (Courtesy [bbc.com/news/world](#))

Bob Dylan Turns 80

The times they are a-changin’, but the music of Bob Dylan remains a constant. The pioneering folk music icon celebrated his 80th birthday last Monday, and fans are commemorated the milestone with a handful of music and poetry events across the country.

At the center of the festivities is Duluth, Minn., where Dylan was born in 1941. Monday marks the third day of the 11th annual Duluth Dylan Fest, which features performances by local artists and tribute bands. The virtual and in-person festival includes a free birthday party at Dylan’s childhood home

The nine-day event also includes songwriting and poetry contests in honor of the acclaimed singer-songwriter.

In New York, Fordham University’s WFUV radio station in the Bronx is set to play 80 Dylan songs on Monday in honor of his age, with the countdown kicking off at 9 a.m.

The celebration stretches beyond the United States. A “Dignity” livestream event saluting Dylan will take place Monday at the U.S. Ambassadors Residence in Dublin, with music, poetry and more on the docket. Dylan, who moved to New York City at the onset of a six-decade career, has recorded more than three dozen studio albums, beginning with his eponymous debut work in 1962. His most recent album, last year’s “Rough and Rowdy Ways,” was a huge hit, peaking at No. 2 in the U.S. and No. 1 in several countries. Revered for his poignant lyrics that gave a voice to the social unrest of the 1960s, Dylan is a 10-time Grammy winner and a 38-time nominee. His anthems “Like a Rolling Stone,” “The Times They Are A-Changin’” and “Blowing in the Wind” are considered among the greatest songs of all time, and are still relevant today in a world with a heightened social consciousness.

While his nasally singing voice is an acquired taste, Dylan’s lasting impact on music and the world continues to resonate, with former President Barack Obama honoring the artist with the Presidential Medal of Freedom in 2012.

“There is not a bigger giant in the history of American music,” Obama said during the ceremony. “All these years later, he’s still chasing that sound and still searching for a little bit of truth, and I have to say I am a really big fan.”

In 2016, the enigmatic artist was awarded the Nobel Prize in Literature for “having created new poetic expressions within the great American song tradition,” according to the Swedish Academy.

Dylan, a member of the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame and Songwriters Hall of Fame, won the Academy Award for best original song in 2001 for “Things Have Changed,” which appeared in the comedy-drama “Wonder Boys.”
