Biden says he'll speak to China's Xi about balloon incident

WASHINGTON, Feb 16 (Reuters) - President Joe Biden said on Thursday he expects to speak with China's President Xi Jinping about what the United States says was a Chinese spy balloon that a U.S. fighter jet shot down early this month after it transited the United States.

"We are not looking for a new cold war," Biden said.

Biden, in his most extensive remarks about the Chinese balloon and three unidentified objects downed by U.S. fighters, did not say when he would speak with Xi, but said the United States was continuing to engage diplomatically with China on the issue.

"I expect to be speaking with President Xi, I hope we are going to get to the bottom of this, but I make no apologies for taking down that balloon," Biden said in response to complaints from Beijing.

China says the 200-foot (60-meter) balloon was for monitoring weather conditions, but Washington says it clearly was a surveillance balloon with a massive undercarriage containing electronics.

Biden, who had offered few public comments about the spate of aerial objects that began with the spotting of the Chinese balloon, broke his silence after lawmakers demanded more information on the incidents, which have baffled many Americans.

He said the U.S. intelligence community was still trying to learn more about the three unidentified objects: one that was shot down over Alaska, one over Canada and a third that plunged into Lake Huron. The administration has said they were downed because they posed a threat to civil aviation.

"We don't yet know exactly what these three objects were, but nothing right now suggests they were related to the Chinese spy balloon program or they were surveillance vehicles from any other country," Biden said.

The intelligence community believes the objects were "most likely balloons tied to private companies, recreation or research institutions," Biden said.

Biden said they might have been spotted due to enhanced radar in response to the Chinese balloon.

"That's why I've directed my team to come back to me with sharper rules for how we will deal with these unidentified objects moving forward, distinguishing between



those that are likely to pose safety and security risks that necessitate action and those that do not."

The remarks came amid reports that the Chinese balloon downed on Feb. 4 after crossing the continental United States originally had a trajectory that would have taken it over Guam and Hawaii but was blown off course by prevailing winds.

The incident prompted U.S. Secretary of State Antony Blinken to postpone a planned visit to Beijing, where both sides had sought to stabilize already fraught relations.

Blinken's scheduled attendance at the Munich Security Conference this weekend has raised speculation that he could meet China's top diplomat Wang Yi there.

John Bolton, a national security advisor during the Trump administration, said on Twitter that he had been briefed on Wednesday by the U.S. intelligence community and remained "profoundly troubled about the Biden Administration's handling of these potential national-security threats," citing what he called its "changing story line."

The Washington Post reported on Tuesday that U.S. military and intelligence agencies tracked the balloon from when it lifted off from China's southern island province of Hainan.

It was shot down off the coast of South Carolina, and American lawmakers have slammed the administration for letting it first drift across the country, including near sensitive military bases.

Asked in advance about Biden's remarks, a China's

foreign ministry spokesman on Thursday once again referred to the downed balloon as an "unmanned civilian airship," and said its flight into U.S. airspace was an "isolated" incident.

The U.S. "should be willing to meet China in the middle, manage differences and appropriately handle isolated, unexpected incidents to avoid misunderstandings and misjudgments; and promote the return of U.S.-China relations to a healthy and stable development track," spokesman Wang Wenbin told reporters at a regular briefing.

Beijing had criticized Washington for overreacting by shooting down the balloon, and warned of "countermeasures against relevant U.S. entities that undermine China's sovereignty and security."

On Thursday, China put Lockheed Martin Corp (LMT.N) and a unit of Raytheon Technologies Corp (RTX.N) on an "unreliable entities list" over arms sales to Taiwan, banning them from imports and exports related to China in its latest sanctions against the U.S. companies.

In Celebration Of Asian American And Pacific Islander Heritage Month

Asian American Business Leaders Launch Effort to Fight Anti-Asian Discrimination

Hundreds March In Los Angeles To Protest Asian Hate And Violence Against Asians.

Overview

Anti-Asian discrimination, fueled by xenophobia and racist beliefs about the coronavirus, have plagued the AAPI community this past year. In order to promote equity and justice for all, citizens must fight racism and support people of Asian descent. Violence and discrimination against Asian Americans has surged over the past year. The United Nations calls on all countries to promote equity, tolerance, and inclusion — without doing so, we'll never end extreme poverty.

Amid a global rise in hate crimes against people of Asian descent over the past year, many individuals have decided to take a stand. From raising money to ensure Asian people feel safe to organizations fighting racism and discrimination, people around the world are attempting to end the bigotry and ignorance that leads to hate.

Now, a group of Asian American business leaders have launched a new initiative to help, pledging \$125 million over the next five years to The Asian American Foundation (AAAF), according to the New York Times.

AAAF will prioritize efforts in three areas — anti-hate, education, and data and research — to correct discriminatory practices that have plagued the Asian American and Pacific Islander (AAPI) community.

Within these areas, AAAF seeks to build long-term solutions to defeat anti-Asian discrimination, invest in data-driven research to inform future policymaking, and create school curriculums that reflect the history of AAPI people in the US.

The total \$250 million pledge is the largest philanthropic effort to support the AAPI community, according to the New York Times.

So far, AAAF has distributed several grants, including \$1 million to support the efforts of Stop AAPI Hate. The foundation says these grants will provide support to the organizations monitoring anti-AAPI hate to help build systems to measure and defend against anti-Asian hate in the long term.

"AAPI communities need systemic change to ensure we are better supported, represented, and celebrated across all aspects of American life," Shah said. "AAAF plans to spark that systemic change and help fundamentally transform AAPI empowerment and support well into the future." (Courtesy glovalcitizen.org)

The population of Asian Americans in the US grew 81% between 2000 and 2019, making it the fastest growing pop-

ulation among all racial and ethnic groups in the United States, according to the Pew Research Center. The community is projected to grow even more rapidly in the coming years.

Asian Americans living in the US have experienced a sharp rise in hate crimes amid the COVID-19 pandemic, which has fueled racism and xenophobia.

The group Stop AAPI Hate, which tracks anti-Asian violence and harassment, received 3,795 reports of incidents between the period of March 19, 2020 to Feb. 28, 2021, and noted that this number represents only a fraction of the number of hate incidents that actually occur against members of the AAPI community.

"We created TAAF to stand up for the 23 million Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders living in this country and help bring us all together in the fight for our own prosperity," said Sonal Shah, president of TAAF. "TAAF wants to strengthen and build power for AAPIs, particularly as we face an exponential increase in hate and violence."

The founders board of TAAF is chaired by Li Lu, founder of hedge fund Himalaya Capital, and includes billionaires Jerry Yang, co-founder of Yahoo, and Joseph Tsai, co-founder of Alibaba Group Holding, according to Reuters.

A number of partners are supporting the new initiative, and the Coca-Cola Company, Walmart, Bank of America, the Ford Foundation, and the National Basketball Association have donated an additional \$125 million, according to TAAF.



Over the past year, at least 3,800 hate incidents against Asian Americans have been reported amid the COVID-19 pandemic, which activists say were stoked by misinformation and rising anti-Asian rhetoric from political figures and media pundits.

The shootings in Atlanta, Georgia, on Tuesday that killed eight people, including six Asian women, took place amid this violence and further highlighted discussions about years-long harassment and discrimination against people of Asian descent in the US and around the world. While officials are still investigating whether hate crime charges should be brought against the shooting suspect, according to AP, advocates say there can be no obscuring the bigger picture.

"That the Asian women murdered yesterday were working highly vulnerable and low-wage jobs during an ongoing pandemic speaks directly to the compounding impacts of misogyny, structural violence, and white supremacy," said Phi Nguyen, litigation director at Asian American Advancing Justice in Atlanta, in a statement.

Anti-Asian hatred in the US isn't happening in a vacuum, shaped only by COVID-19 misinformation. It's taking place against the backdrop of history. Between imperial wars of aggression, domestic policies of exclusion, and offensive media depictions, bigotry against Asians is deeply embedded in US society.

The fight for racial justice requires that everyone learn this history and understand how it continues to shape reality today. It also requires everyone to show solidarity with Asian Americans and take concrete steps to stop hatred and violence, including learning how to engage in bystander intervention.





US President Joe Biden signed the COVID-19 Hate Crimes Act Thursday to address the nationwide surge in hate crimes against Asian Americans over the past year. The signing of the bipartisan legislation follows testimony from experts about the rise in violence and grassroots pressure to protect Asian American communities. Biden spoke about the urgency of the matter while signing the law.

"All of this hate hides in plain sight," Biden said at the White House. "Too often it is met with silence — silence by the media, silence by our politics, and silence by our history." The law seeks to break that silence by improving law enforcement capabilities for dealing with hate crimes. Law enforcement agencies will receive training to better identify hate crimes, while officials will also deploy public education campaigns and create hate crime hotlines. The Justice Department will install someone to accelerate the agency's review of hate crimes. Efforts to improve data collection around hate crimes will also commence.

Over the past year, more than 6,600 hate crimes have been reported against Asian-Americans, according to the advocacy group Stop AAPI Hate. Experts point to misinformation surrounding COVID-19 and rising anti-Asian rhetoric from political figures and media pundits as instigating factors of the violence. The majority of crimes have taken place in parks, public streets, and businesses, and people report that verbal harassment, shunning, and physical attacks are the most common types of hate crime experienced. The public nature of these attacks has caused a feeling of dread to



如今作為完結篇，《魔力麥克3》迎來了導演史蒂文·索德伯格，編劇雷德·卡羅林和主演查寧·塔圖姆等主創的悉數回歸。

有點遺憾的是，前兩部中有着亮眼表現的馬修·麥康納、馬特·波莫、喬·曼根尼羅沒能重返舞男團。

好在女演員方面新加入了薩爾瑪·海耶克，算得上是一個小小驚喜吧。

來自墨西哥的薩爾瑪·海耶克早年憑《殺出個黎明》（1996）中的一段絕美舞蹈驚艷四方，由此走上性感女神路線。這一次的她則完成了角色的變換，從提供美色的艷舞女郎轉變為一位消費男色的富婆。

《星際傳奇4》 仍由原班人馬打造



文·迪塞爾（Vin Diesel）手裡頭有三大系列電影，《速度與激情》不用多說，一直拍到現在。但另外兩個系列《xXx》和《星際傳奇》就沒那麼風光了，迪塞爾沒有忘掉它們，他在2013年拍了《星際傳奇3》，但那部電影沒給人留下多少印象。

這影響到了《星際傳奇4》的籌備，這個項目一直拖拖拖，直到最近才有實質性進展。

就在周五，迪塞爾宣布，他將和前三集《星際傳奇》導演大衛·圖奇（David Twohy）搭檔，拍攝《星際傳奇4》（Riddick: Fury）。

《星際傳奇》系列是以文·迪塞爾飾演的宇宙通緝犯「瑞迪克」為主角的系列星際科幻冒險動作電影，他來自「福瑞雅星球」（Furya），在《星際傳奇4》中，瑞迪克第一次重返母星，見到了一些還倖存着的同胞們。

這也是該系列首次探索「瑞迪克」的身世起源。

《星際傳奇》系列由2000年的《星際傳奇》（Pitch Black）、2004年的《星際傳奇2》（The Chronicles of Riddick）和2013年的《星際傳奇3》（Riddick）構成。

三部電影裡最好看的還是第一部，那部也是迪塞爾的顏值巔峰。

除了電影，《星際傳奇》還有動畫片、漫畫和遊戲。

《星際傳奇4》將會是R級片，目前還沒有檔期。

時隔8年，「R級之作」終於回歸

這一部的劇情相對獨立，與前兩部電影關聯不大，故事風格也略有區別。

魔力麥克（查寧·塔圖姆飾）在生意失敗後陷入破產，鬱鬱寡歡的他在邁阿密干着一份酒保的工作，在一次豪華派對中，他認識了瑪克桑德拉（薩爾瑪·海耶克飾）。

寂寥的中年富婆遇上了落魄的前脫衣舞男，這就如乾柴烈火，兩人大火速陷入愛河。

正值如膠似漆之際，富婆提出了一個會令所有舞男心動的offer——跟着她去倫敦發展，在最久負盛名的劇院裡舉辦一場激動人心的演出。

麥克接受了這個從天而降的好運，但也要開始面對他所陌生的「舞蹈」環境。在英國的劇院圈子裡，舞者們都是專業的班子，劇場上演的都是知名「大劇」。

而「脫衣舞」在大眾眼裡始終是低端、情色、不入流的娛樂項目，他能憑一身腱子肉征服英國觀眾麼？

他和瑪克桑德拉的關係經歷了初相遇的火熱之後，開始出現問題，地位、財富懸殊的富婆和舞男之間的愛情，走下去也不太容易……

《魔力麥克》系列的前兩部愛情戲份略少，查寧·塔圖姆飾演的麥克是全片的重心。導演以男性視角出發，但這個系列絕大多數的受眾又是女性，查寧在接受訪問時就表示過「這就像是一條長羽毛的魚，太怪了。」

第三部做出了調整，導演會以女性視角重新出發，薩爾瑪·海耶克飾演的女主瑪克桑德拉會擁有和麥克一樣，甚至更多的戲份。

兩人的愛情曲折、對性的反思也會成為完結篇重要的落腳點，這也是電影選擇在情人節前夕上映的原因。

《魔力麥克》系列算得上好萊塢的一匹黑馬，之所以爆火，很大程度上來源於主演查寧·塔圖姆真實的脫衣舞男經歷的噱頭。

（《失控玩家》裡也有過調侃）。

查寧18歲的時候，在佛羅里達州坦帕市一家夜總會當過9個月脫衣舞男。

當這段經歷被爆出來以後，經紀公司焦頭爛額，他卻大方承認了，還表示那段經歷很美好。至於電影的拍攝，查寧乾脆自己做起製片人和主演。

第一部中他飾演的脫衣舞男劇場頭牌麥克，歲月蹉跎、漸漸也走下坡路，這時的他遇到了新人亞歷克斯，年輕帥氣有野心。這讓麥克想起了當年的自己，於是，他開始訓練起這個新人，完成新老一代的交替。

第二部是個公路故事，麥克已經是行業的佼佼者，他逐漸萌生退意，於是約定一次旅行，旅行的終點舉辦一場盛大的狂歡告別表演。

兩部電影貢獻了大量脫衣舞男的表演，馬修·麥康納、馬特·波莫、喬·曼根尼羅等男演員的身體表演會讓電影院爆發一陣陣的尖叫歡呼。

為了演好脫衣舞男的角色，各個演員都挺賣力。

查寧每天早上要進行騎車爬山游泳的訓練，拍攝裸露戲的時候會好幾天吃飯不放鹽，其他男演員也都健身節食一起上，水煮雞胸肉是常備。

幾位男演員里，狼叔喬·曼根尼羅是公認練得最好的，據說海報里他的肌肉還被p小了一丟丟，不然就太誇張。

為了貼合角色形象和心理，男演員還在各大俱樂部體驗過生活，包括尺度很大的脫衣舞廳。

後來成為奧斯卡影帝的馬修·麥康納當年一邊看一邊嚷嚷，「天啊太下流了」，但最後都一併給學了。他在片中飾演的金錢至上的老闆達拉斯，給觀眾留下了深刻的印象。

《魔力麥克》在2012年洛杉磯電影節

上首映，同年9月院線上映，北美評論和票房都一路飄紅。

這部電影是查寧和導演史蒂文·索德伯格一起籌的錢，700萬的成本以及R級的分級本來註定是部小眾電影，沒想到上映後竟然換來1.7億美元的全球票房。

刨除華納的發行和院線方的分成和其他費用後，查寧和史蒂文·索德伯格兩人分錢簡直不要太快樂。

因為第一部的成功，《魔力麥克2》的成本升至1480萬美元，於2015年上映，很多場面特別是結尾處的登台演出，明顯看出了有錢了，台子大了，燈光也炫起來了，動作設計都更上一層樓。

第二部中索德伯格放下導筒，承擔攝影剪輯和製片的工作。但是，劇本是查寧親自寫了一部分，非專業選手上手果真不太行，拖沓的故事也受到了一定的負面評價。

《魔力麥克2》的全球票房也終止在1.23億美元，沒能超越第一部。

這幾年，國內的觀眾很少再聽到《魔力麥克》系列的相關消息，但是在歐美，在資本孵化的市場裡，「魔力麥克」已經成為一個影響力廣泛的IP，不僅僅局限在電影這一塊。

在澳洲，倫敦，拉斯維加斯等地，都有「魔力麥克」脫衣舞男的巡演，查寧是整個項目的執行人。

2021年，HBO Max就宣佈了與《魔力麥克》IP的合作，上線《尋找魔力麥克》的真人秀——邀請十名男性參加選秀，勝出者會得到高額獎金；贏取加入「魔力麥克」舞團的資格。

總之，借着完結篇《魔力麥克3：最後一舞》的北美上映，喜歡浪漫愛情、熱力激情，想感受這個尺度很大但又有真實原型的電影，不妨趁此補片，說不定也有新的驚喜。

因為版權保護到期，「小熊維尼」（Winnie-the-Pooh）、「小鹿斑比」（Bambi）都已經或即將進入公共版權領域。這意味着任何人都可以拿它們來創作。

英國導演Rhys Frake-Waterfield已經捷足先登，把《小熊維尼》拍成了恐怖片，這部名為《小熊維尼：血與蜜》（Winnie-the-Pooh: Blood and Honey）的電影已經在墨西哥上映，並且拿到了近百萬美元的票房。

這位導演還將拍攝《小飛俠：噩夢島》（Peter Pan's Neverland Nightmare），和《小鹿斑比》、「小熊維尼」一起組成黑暗童話宇宙。

順便解釋一下，這些文學形象進入公共版權領域，指的是它們出現的小說已經進入公共版權領域。迪士尼的動畫片還沒有進入公共版權領域，也就是說直接用迪士尼創造的卡通形象還是會侵犯版權的。

說白了，《血與蜜》就是一部低成本B級片，但隨着熱度上升，該片的續集也將鳥槍換炮，據說預算要增加五倍！

但恐怖片《小熊維尼2》還不是Rhys Frake-Waterfield的下部電影，他下部電影將是嗜血版《小鹿斑比》（Bambi: The Reckoning），據他的形容，這將會是《侏羅紀公園》和迪士尼《小鹿斑比》動畫片的結合。

影片也會很像2017年英國／瑞典恐怖片《黑森林》（The Ritual），後者說的是一群大學生到瑞典森林裡徒步探險，結果遭遇神秘怪獸。

總之，小鹿斑比要變成殺人機器了。
